Dear Herr Professor,

I have read with interest and profit your recent pamphlets Recht und Rechtfertigung and Die Kirche und die politische Frage.

I enclose a statement of proposals which are under consideration by the Churches in Great Britain and which are the outcome of 18 months of work, thought and consultation.
