No. 43\* gives Karl Barth's address and sermon in Geneva at the recent Calvin Commemoration. The address, as theologian, deals with three things Calvin has given. An object, viz.: exposition of the Word: an order of themes, Word first, then theology: lastly a "Sphere" to work in, viz.: the Word. The sermon is based on Peter and John healing the cripple at the Temple gate.
