

Resolution.

The General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church, U.S.A., meeting in Columbus, May ~~1931~~, 1937, sends affectionate and fraternal greetings to the Christian Church in Germany. We rejoice in the loyalty and sacrificial heroism of our brethren in Christ who today are standing as did the Reformers for the eternal Gospel. We too are heirs of the same faith. We acknowledge gladly the same Confession of Faith lately promulgated by the German Evangelical Church affirming that: "Jesus Christ as he is testified to us in Holy Scripture is the one Word of God, which we have to hear and which we have to trust and obey in life and death. We reject the false doctrine that the church might and must acknowledge as sources of its proclamation still other events, powers, forms, and truths as God's revelation, apart from the one and only Word of God". We affirm this same faith and convey to our Christian brethren in Germany our sympathetic understanding of this confessional statement and their loyalty to it. We wish our German brethren to know that they do not stand alone. We too stand with them in the same Christian faith, and affirm with the Great Reformer, "Here we stand. We can do no other. God help us. "
