## ● **KARL BARTH** . . . on Church & State

● ONE great, unsolved problem overshadows all the churches today. This is the problem of relations between church and state. One Christian thinker and leader, internationally famed, has been driven into head-on conflict with a state over this problem. This is Karl Barth, Europe's most provocative, most exciting theologian. Barth has been forced to leave Germany, to go back to teaching in Switzerland, by his refusal to take orders from the Nazi Reich.
