Sammlung von Vorlesungen und einiger
kleinerer Arbeiten sind ja diesem
Buche bereits vorangesungen." "The Word of
God and the word of man", of course, I know;
also 'The Christian Life' published by the Student-
Christian Movement. I can discover no other to
explain the plural einiger kleineren Arbeiten.
