
Dear Dr. Barth:

Dr. Visser t'Hooft of the World Christian Student Foundation called my attention to a significant statement of yours with reference to the church situation in Germany which ~~he~~ thought was the best statement ~~he~~ knew of concerning that important conflict. We are just now beginning the publication of a new magazine which specializes in condensation of articles from the press of the world bearing on the mission of world Christianity. Thus the article referred to would be directly within the line of our interest. I think Dr. Visser t'Hooft stated that this article appeared in the *Zwingli Yearbook*. He thought that if I wrote directly to you you would perhaps be willing to grant us permission either to copy your article or to condense it in a future issue of *World Christianity*, and that perhaps you would see to it that we receive a copy of said report. We would be deeply grateful if you could send us the report and would be more than glad to reimburse you for any expense incurred in securing and sending it to us.

Many readers of our periodical are warm sympathizers with your point of view and have greatly admired the stand you have taken in the German church crisis. They would, therefore, greatly appreciate such an article from you. Needless to say we will send you a copy of the issue of the magazine in which this statement appears.
